- An understanding of the grief process
- Skills to cope with grief and loss
- An opportunity to memorialize and say goodbye to loved ones

To Attend

Complete a camp application no later than **February 2** (online at www.HopeHCS.org/RainbowTrailsCamp). After review you will receive confirmation that a reservation is held for you and your camper(s). *Please let us know in advance if plans change so families on the waiting list may be enrolled.*

A parent/guardian must accompany the camper(s). Camp time is 9 am to 5 pm, a light breakfast and lunch will be provided. Parking is free. The camp itinerary includes creative, stress-reducing activities including crafts, music and art. While Rainbow Trails may have a serious purpose, families will have plenty of fun.
